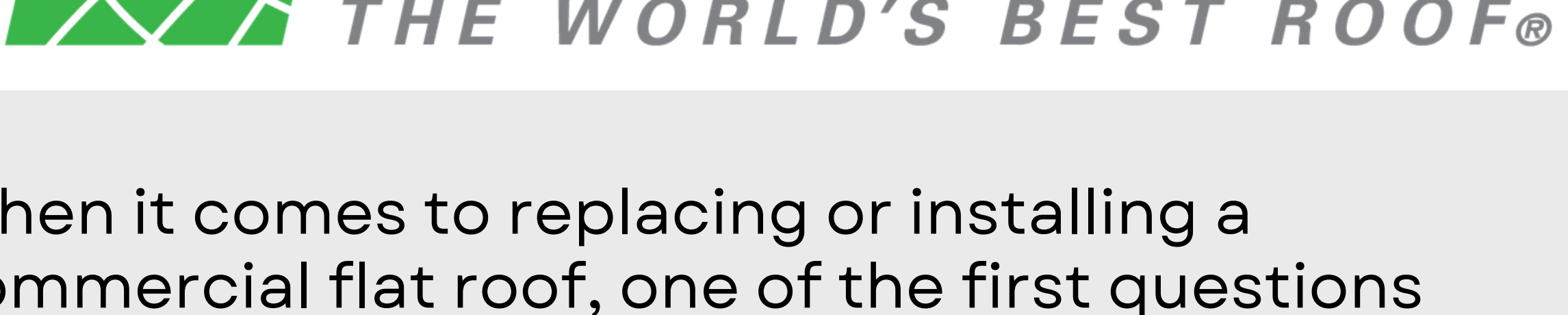


WHAT ACTUALLY DRIVES THE COST OF A COMMERCIAL FLAT ROOF?
